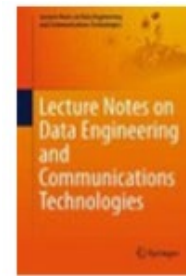
Artificial Intelligence & the Future of English as an Additional Language (AIFEAL)
